8           (1) IN GENERAL.—For an additional amount  
9 for “Procurement” for the Department of Defense,  
10 \$5,232,000,000, to remain available until expended,  
11 to manufacture or acquire vehicles, equipment, am-  
12 munition, and materials required to reconstitute  
13 military units to an acceptable readiness rating and  
14 to restock prepositioned assets and war reserve ma-  
15 terial.

16           (2) AVAILABILITY.—The items for which the  
17 amount available under paragraph (1) shall be avail-  
18 able shall include fixed and rotary wing aircraft,  
19 tracked and non-tracked combat vehicles, missiles,  
20 weapons, ammunition, communications equipment,  
21 maintenance equipment, naval coastal warfare boats,  
22 salvage equipment, riverine equipment, expeditionary  
23 material handling equipment, and other expedi-  
24 tionary items.

1           (3) ALLOCATION AMONG PROCUREMENT AC-  
2           COUNTS.—The amount available under paragraph  
3           (1) shall be allocated among the accounts of the De-  
4           partment of Defense for procurement in such man-  
5           ner as the President considers appropriate. The  
6           President shall submit to the congressional defense  
7           committees a report setting for the manner of the  
8           allocation of such amount among such accounts and  
9           a description of the items procured utilizing such  
10          amount.

11          (4) CONGRESSIONAL DEFENSE COMMITTEES  
12          DEFINED.—In this subsection, the term “congres-  
13          sional defense committees” has the meaning given  
14          that term in section 101(a)(16) of title 10, United  
15          States Code.

16          (b) OFFSET.—

17          (1) PERIODIC CENSUSES AND PROGRAMS.—The  
18          amount appropriated by title II under the heading  
19          “BUREAU OF THE CENSUS” under the heading  
20          “PERIODIC CENSUSES AND PROGRAMS” is hereby re-  
21          duced by \$1,000,000,000.

22          (2) DIGITAL-TO-ANALOG COMPUTER BOX PRO-  
23          GRAM.—The amount appropriated by title II under  
24          the heading “NATIONAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS  
25          AND INFORMATION ADMINISTRATION” under the

1 heading “DIGITAL-TO-ANALOG CONVERTER BOX PRO-  
2 GRAM” is hereby reduced by \$650,000,000.

3 (3) PROCUREMENT, ACQUISITION, AND CON-  
4 STRUCTION FOR NOAA.—The amount appropriated  
5 by title II under the heading “NATIONAL OCEANIC  
6 AND ATMOSPHERIC ADMINISTRATION” under the  
7 heading “PROCUREMENT, ACQUISITION, AND CON-  
8 STRUCTION” is hereby reduced by \$70,000,000, with  
9 the amount of the reduction allocated to amounts  
10 available for supercomputing activities relating to  
11 climate change research.

12 (4) DEPARTMENTAL MANAGEMENT FOR DE-  
13 PARTMENT OF COMMERCE.—The amount appro-  
14 priated by title II under the heading “DEPART-  
15 MENT OF COMMERCE” under the heading “DE-  
16 PARTMENTAL MANAGEMENT” is hereby reduced by  
17 \$34,000,000.

18 (5) FEDERAL BUILDINGS FUND FOR GSA.—The  
19 amount appropriated by title V under the heading  
20 “GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION”  
21 under the heading “REAL PROPERTY ACTIVITIES”  
22 under the heading “FEDERAL BUILDINGS FUND” is  
23 hereby reduced by \$2,000,000,000, with the amount  
24 of the reduction allocated to amounts available for

1 measures necessary to convert GSA facilities to  
2 High-Performance Green Buildings.

3 (6) ENERGY-EFFICIENT FEDERAL MOTOR VEHI-  
4 CLE FLEET PROCUREMENT FOR GSA.—The amount  
5 appropriated by title V under the heading “GEN-  
6 ERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION” under the  
7 heading “ENERGY-EFFICIENT FEDERAL MOTOR VE-  
8 HICLE FLEET PROCUREMENT” is hereby reduced by  
9 \$600,000,000.

10 (7) RESOURCE MANAGEMENT FOR US FISH AND  
11 WILDLIFE SERVICE.—The amount appropriated by

21 (8) OPERATING EXPENSES FOR CORPORATION  
22 FOR NATIONAL AND COMMUNITY SERVICE.—The  
23 amount appropriated by title VIII under the heading  
24 “CORPORATION FOR NATIONAL AND COM-  
25 MUNITY SERVICE” under the heading “OPER-

1       ATING EXPENSES” is hereby reduced by  
2       \$13,000,000, with the amount of reduction allocated  
3       to amounts available for research activities author-  
4       ized under subtitle H of title I of the 1990 Act.

5               (9) SUPPLEMENTAL CAPITAL GRANTS TO THE  
6       NATIONAL RAILROAD PASSENGER CORPORATION.—  
7       The amount appropriated by title XII under the  
8       heading “FEDERAL RAILROAD ADMINISTRATION”  
9       under the heading “SUPPLEMENTAL CAPITAL  
10      GRANTS TO THE NATIONAL RAILROAD PASSENGER  
11      CORPORATION” is hereby reduced by \$850,000,000.
